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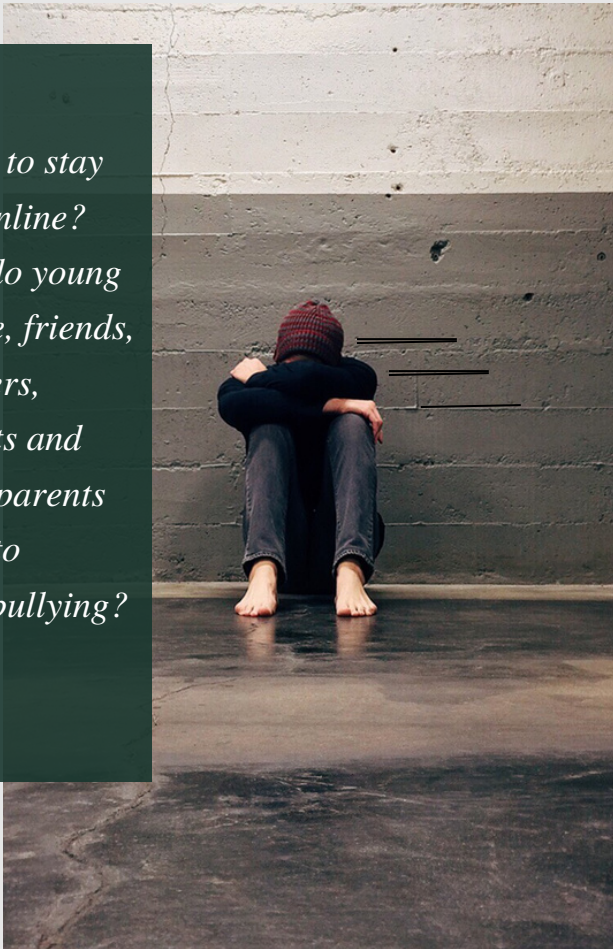

**TABASCO** aims to develop mechanisms to detect online abuse and support young victims. The project also focuses on drawing the attention of other stakeholders to the specific measures and tools developed through the programme activities in the fight against bullying in general and cyberbullying in particular.

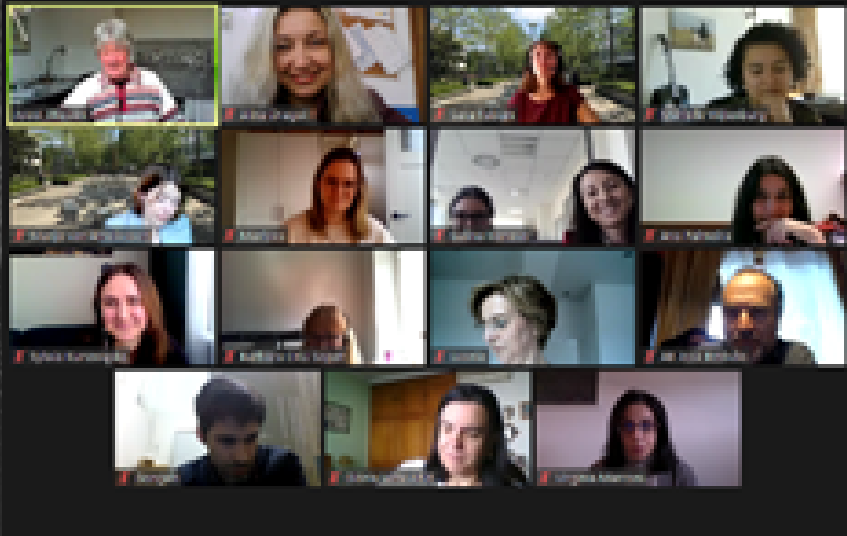
